Editor Summary

The functions of the Liberty BASIC editor you really need are:

- File > New Basic Source File
- File > Open...
- File > Exit

Once you have a file to work with, you need:

- File > Save
- File > SaveAs...
- Edit > (Undo, Cut, Copy, Paste, Select All, Find Again, Find/Replace)
- Run > Run (or easier, the blue **Run** button)

Finally, you always really really need:

- Help > Liberty BASIC Help Document

If you look under **Help > Liberty BASIC Language > Using the Editor**, you will find explanations for all of the editor's options and functions, including the ones you won't need for a long time.
